This release contains eight enhancements and sixteen fixes.



2. What's New in this Release

Requirements User Interface

A totally new User Interface is being introduced for Accept over the next twelve months. The new interface has been written in HTML and will run in all widely used browsers - IE, Chrome, Firefox and Safari. The new interface offers much improved usability and offers a consistent front-end for all the modules.

A decision has been made to introduce the new user interface on a modular basis starting with the Requirements module in this release. The Requirements module new interface offers all functionality of the existing module including both table and list views and customer filter capabilities. Additional modules will be introduced in successive product releases and the product will have an entirely new UI by the end of 2016.
