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1. Release Overview

The Accept Enterprise 2016.2 release includes the new Requirements Use Interface as well as addressing a number of issues reported by customers in earlier releases.

This release contains seven enhancements and fifteen fixes.

2. What's new in this release

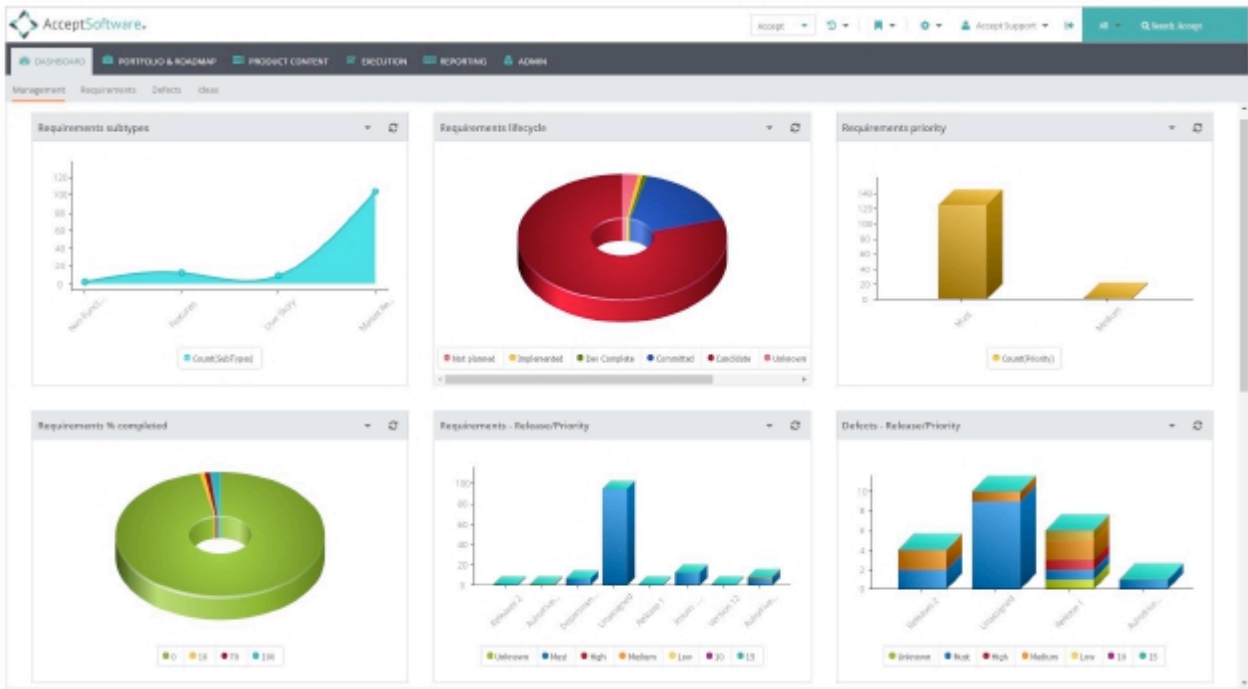
2.1. Requirements User Interface

A totally new User Interface is being introduced for Accept over the next twelve months. The new interface has been written in HTML 5.0 and will run in all widely used browsers - IE, Chrome, Firefox and Safari. The new interface offers improved usability as well as a consistent front-end for all the modules.

A decision has been made to introduce the new user interface on a modular basis starting with the Requirements module which was added in 2016.1. The Requirements module new interface offers all the functionality of the existing module including both table and list views and custom filter capabilities. In 2016.2, we have added Defects, Ideas, Strategies and a completely new Dashboard. All these modules incorporate the new user interface. Additional modules will be introduced in successive product releases and the product will have an entirely new UI by the end of 2016.

In the interim period, both the XUL Launcher and the New UI components will both be available.


